

Legumes should make up 40-60 percent of the forage stand. Hay fields should contain legume percentages closer to 60 percent to compensate for the nitrogen. Removed with the hay. Pasture systems allow for more recycling of nutrients as nitrogen is excreted back onto the fields in the form of manure and urine. Maintaining legume stand near 40 percent is the desired target for pasture.


